Project Summery	<p>Project Goal:Women in Rangpur division who are in crisis¹ from leprosy and other causes will have access to a safe, loving retreat while their resettlement into a safe community (preferably their original community) is arranged.</p> <p>Project Objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Women who are in crisis live in a safe retreat and gain confidence. • Women who were in crisis are accepted by their community/family <p>.Key activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maintain safe “retreat” environment,(Bed occupancy 12) • Staff available for informal discussion at least 8 hours a day, 6 days a week. • Kitchen and living areas maintained to safe standard (Continue) • Food stipends distributed on time so women can purchase and prepare food.(the number counted per month mother 12 and children 6) • Relevant medical care sought for women as required (maternal child health as well as other relevant treatment). • Inform relevant groups of people in churches and NGOs about the facilities offered • Follow-up on any referrals within 48 hours by phone. • Follow-up referrals with physical visit within a week • Collect intake information (demographics as well as a written summary of their story) within 2 days of admission • Arrange CBVT for potential women • Arrange follow-up visits to community to promote reintegration • Advocate with government/NGO’s for necessary legal support as required. • Accompany women to any legal meetings/appointments • Ensure return to community is safe and that “fail safes” are in place • Regular follow up at home at least 3 times following discharge • Arrange for the referring organization to follow up and ensure the woman is safe.
